

RSPCA Australia National Statistics 2003-2004

The RSPCA receives thousands of animals every year in every State and Territory in Australia. Annual statistics on the numbers of animals received, reclaimed or rehomed are compiled on a national basis by RSPCA Australia. The following statistics cover the 2003 to 2004 financial year and give details on the receipt and placement of animals by each State and Territory RSPCA during that period. 

Figure 1: The fate of animals received by the RSPCA in 2002-2003





Figure 2: Animals received over the past five years







Convictions







Figure 5: Total Members by Category




