

RSPCA Australia National Statistics 2005-2006

The RSPCA receives thousands of animals every year in every State and Territory in Australia. Annual statistics on the numbers of animals received, reclaimed or rehomed are compiled on a national basis by RSPCA Australia. The following statistics cover the 2005 to 2006 financial year and give details on the receipt and placement of animals by each state and territory RSPCA during that period. We also compile data relating to the RSPCA inspectorate, membership and volunteers.



Figure 1: The fate of animals received by the RSPCA in 2005-2006





Figure 2: Animals received over the past five years







Convictions




